Research indicates life expectancy across the globe has increased by 25 years in recent decades and that by 2050, the number of people aged 65 and older will double, exceeding two billion individuals. An aging population inevitably entails a radical change in society, in the world of work, in social organization, and in the public-private relationship of health care, pensions, mobility, and urban planning. It calls for a commitment to promote research and preventive medicine that both increase longevity and nurture good health throughout an individual's life span.

All of this and more will be discussed for two weeks this March at the Milan Longevity Summit where the world's most accredited international researchers will convene, amidst the daily barrage of information from the media and social platforms, to dispel false myths and discern where science stands on these critical issues, all fundamental to our collective future.

In a series of high-level meetings designed to involve the entire city in this debate, scientists and scholars will be joined by representatives of institutions, academia, international advocacy groups, politicians, third-sector foundations, hospitals, national and international companies, investors, market analysts, urban planners, start-up founders, labor lawyers, and demographers.

With a view to extending the possibility of a longer life in good health to the entire population, not just to the privileged few, we hope that the irrationality of violence, the destructive greed for money, and the bloodshed of wars will not eradicate the biblical promise of a life that can last 120 years.




